

ZONE 7 CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE SERIES COMPETITION REGULATIONS CHANGES FOR 2022

Rule 7.2.8

The percentage requirement when calculating the 4 Overall category winners was eliminated. The Overall winners of the 4 Categories (Street, Touring, Full, and Unrestored) will be determined by total points only, as received during the current Concours year's competition.

Awards shall be given to the overall winner of each of the four Categories (Street, Touring, Full, Unrestored) based on the highest total points scored, relative to points possible for the class in which the entrant competed, as long as three or more participants are eligible for year-end Zone awards in that Category.

For instance, if there are only two class winners for Unrestored, no overall award for Unrestored will be given in that year.

(In order to encourage more participation in the Concours series, it should be noted that attending more concours events than your competition becomes a scoring advantage in determining year end Zone Awards). This rule allows a participant, who has attended more Concours events than the minimum required to drop their lowest score/s, therefor gaining a higher point total. This could result in a participant being determined the winner in a class, but in those cases where another participant has been awarded all perfect scores (100% of available points) in required minimum number of Concours events, the resulting lower score drop could only result a tie for 1st place. In no case could a cumulative series score of 100% (of available points) be awarded less than 1st place. This scoring rule also applies to year end Zone awards.

Rule 10.4 Category and Class Divisions

The Unrestored Category (U) was adjusted to include newer year models. Basic rule is that the car must be 21 years old or older.

Division U5 – 911's 1989 to 1998, 964 & 993. Updated to include up to the year 2000.

Division U6 – 911's 1999 to 2000, 996 & 997. Updated to include up to the year 2002.

Division U8 – 924, 944, 928, 968. – Updated to include all years of production

Division U9 – Boxster, Cayman – Updated to include up to the year 2002

Division S10, T10 & C10 – Cayenne, Panamera, Macan & Taycan – Updated to include the Taycan.
