- 1.) Updates: This schedule is subject to change and will be periodically updated.
- **2.) Registration:** Register for events at www.motorsportreg.com. Events noted as "Registration Open" will fill-up quick, especially for student drivers, so it is recommended that you sign-up ASAP.
- **3.)** Helmets and Clothing: A Snell SA 2015 helmet or newer is required. Motorcycle helmets are not allowed. Closed toe shoes with track appropriate soles, cotton long sleeve shirts and long pants are required.
- **4.) Vehicle:** Per PCA guidelines, all drivers must have their cars Tech inspected by a qualified shop within 30 days of the event and submit the event organizer's competed Safety Tech Inspection form at the event. Be sure your vehicle is in top condition and your brakes and tires are adequate for the event. Brake fluid should have been flushed within the past 12 months, preferably using high temperature 600 or 660 degree rated fluid.
